Goals for Student Learning

District Goal:

The Board of Education sets goals for the entire district. They are:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3,4) in grades 3-8 on the Georgia Milestones.
- Students will be reading on grade level by 3rd grade
- Increase achievement in Math and Reading
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school

School Goals:

Our school sets academic goals each year for our students.

They are:

Ringgold Primary School will increase Reading Benchmark scores at or above grade level by 10% between fall and spring test in order to better prepare students for the next grade level.

Kindergarten will focus on the following areas for ELA:

- Letter names
- Letter sounds

Ringgold Primary School will increase Math benchmark scores at or above grade level by 10% between fall and spring tests in order to prepare students for the next grade level.

Kindergarten will focus on the following areas for Math:

- Count to 100
- Identify and write numbers 0-20
