<b>Elementary Opportunities</b>		
<b>Elementary 1 week "Olympic" Camp</b>	<b>July 19<sup>th</sup> – July 22<sup>nd</sup> Monday through Thursday</b>	<b>12:30 – 3:30 pm</b>

<b>Elementary and Middle School Band Camp</b>

<p>This four-day band camp is an opportunity for current 4th and 5th grade students to work on ensemble skills, reinforce proper technique and habits, work with several Hudson band directors <b>**in person**</b>, and have some FUN! We will be brushing up on instrument care, reading music, and playing your specific instrument well so that you're confident and prepared to begin September in our band program. Students should plan on bringing their own instrument to the workshops (there may be a few school-owned instruments available- please inquire).</p> <p>Current 5, 6, and 7th graders....are you interested in an instrument switch? We have openings for many of our secondary instruments! Options include: Oboe, Bassoon, Bass Clarinet, Tenor Sax, Bari Sax, French horn, Euphonium/Baritone, and Tuba. This would be a great time to work with band directors in a small setting to see if you'd like to switch to something new for the fall and get a jump start on your new instrument; there are several school-owned instruments available for families to use, first come- first served. Are you interested in joining the band for the first time as a current 6th or 7th grader? This workshop will allow you to catch up to your grade level peers over the summer so you can start the new year with confidence.</p>
