Board Strategic Priorities for 2020-2023

Preamble:

The Board of Trustees begins the process of education planning by reviewing the strategic priorities set out for the three years previous. These strategic priorities remain fairly consistent over the three year planning cycle. The review re-affirms the overall goals of the Division which align with the Mission, Vision and Values, and provides areas of focus for the upcoming year based on reporting data.

On May 1, 2020, the Board of Trustees and Executive Team participated in a strategic planning workshop. Trustees reviewed the “current state of affairs” within the division from their own perspective, received senior administration feedback, brainstormed problems to be solved and looked for future opportunities in order to set the areas of focus for the coming school years.
