

**FALL NOTIFICATION
IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING YOUR STUDENT'S
IMMUNIZATION STATUS!**

This notice serves as prior written notification in accordance with WAC 392-380-050 informing you that Washington State immunization law, RCW 28A 210-120, requires every student in a public school to be fully immunized in order to attend school unless an exemption form is on file.

After **October 2, 2020**, your student will not be able to attend school until you present to the student's school one of the following:

- Complete Certificate of Immunization Status form (CIS),
OR
- Certificate of Exemption form signed by your licensed healthcare provider for medical or personal reasons,
OR
- Certificate of Exemption for religious reasons including documentation of affiliation with a religious organization that specifically prohibits immunizations,
OR
- An appointment card from a licensed health care provider indicating a future immunization appointment date.

The necessary immunizations for your student may be obtained from your licensed health care provider or through Kitsap County Health District at 345 - 6th Street in Bremerton, (360) 728-2235.

If you have questions regarding required immunizations, please contact your student's school. If you need assistance locating a healthcare provider or enrolling in health insurance, please contact your student's school to speak to a nurse.

Washington State Law, (WAC 246-105-080) states that students without adequate immunization status on record or exemption waiver shall be excluded from school. You also have the right to appeal or contest the decision to exclude your child from school according to School Board Policy No. 3413. To appeal this decision, you must provide the school district with a written request for a hearing no later than the third school business day following the day you receive this notification.
