

Who can use the employee clinic?

The GKB employee clinic is available to all GKB employees, their spouses, and their dependents who are still residents of your home, up to age 26. You do not have to carry insurance through GKB in order to make an appointment or see the provider.

Where is the employee clinic?

The GKB employee clinic is located inside of the GKB School Clinic, at the west end of the clinic. Exterior entrance is entrance 1 in the high school parking lot, located off of Britton St. The phone number is 260-357-6717.

When is the clinic open?

The clinic is scheduled on Monday mornings from 7:30-9:30 am and Thursday from 10 am- 1 pm. Variations in the schedule do occur and a monthly schedule is sent out to staff, as well as posted on the wellness portion of the GKB district website.

Who works at the employee clinic?

Medical services are provided by Parkview Health and Parkview Physicians Group. Currently our providers include Dr. Bret Kueber and Kelsey Ellet, NP. Nursing Services are provided by our School Nurse, Tori LaMotte. Clinic staff may also assist with vitals, scheduling, or other duties.

How do I make an appointment and are appointments required? Are same day appointments available?

Appointments are recommended. You may make same day appointments if there are time slots available. You can make an appointment by calling the clinic at 260-357-6717, internally via extension 5311, or by emailing tlamotte@gkb.k12.in.us. Scheduling is also available via myChart after your first visit.

How much does a visit at the clinic cost?

All visits at the employee clinic are no charge. Available services vary depending on if you are a health plan member or not.

Are there medications at the clinic and what is the cost?

There are a select number of medications available at the clinic that can be prescribed and dispensed by the provider. These medications primarily treat common illnesses and conditions. You must be seen by the provider first in order to be prescribed the medication. Medications are only available to be dispensed to health plan members and dependents, at no cost.

For employees and dependents who are not on the health plan, medications will be written and can be filled at a local pharmacy, using your health plan benefits.

Will the clinic offer lab draws?

The clinic is able to offer certain labs for free at the clinic. We will also perform a few basic point of care tests to diagnose strep, urinary tract infections, flu, Covid-19. Mono, etc.

For health plan members/dependents: If you have lab tests, whether ordered by our provider or through another provider, and they are on the list of approved labs, our staff will draw your blood and process the test at no cost to you. The approved lab list is available on the GKB Wellness page of the district website.

For non-health plan members/dependents: Point of care testing is available to you at no cost if ordered by our providers. For lab work, if the lab is on our approved list, you can choose to payroll deduct \$16 per lab to cover the cost. Alternatively, you can take the lab orders have the test completed through your insurance at a lab of your choice.
