Welcome to the 2021-2022 school year!

Clayton County Public Schools will administer Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Growth Assessments to students in grades 2-11 during the 2021-2022 school year. The MAP Growth assessments are given three (3) times during the school year: Fall, Winter, and Spring. Results will be sent home once your child takes the tests. What is MAP?

- MAP Growth assessments are a computer-based assessment which adjusts in difficulty according to your child's responses to the test items. If your child answers a question correctly, the next question is more challenging. If they answer incorrectly, the next one is easier.
- These results provide immediate and accurate information about your child and provide a more complete picture of what your child knows and is ready to learn—whether it is on, above, or below their grade level.
- MAP Growth scores help teachers check students' achievement and growth. Teachers use the results to tailor classroom lessons and set goals for students.

During the weeks of August 16th, your child will take MAP Growth assessments. *Students who are participating in virtual learning may participate in testing remotely while at home or at the school site. Please communicate your plans with your child's teacher.*
