

8110 ATTENDANCE AREAS

Determination

The boundary lines of individual school attendance areas are determined by the Board of Education to maintain a reasonable distribution among schools.

Transfer

When change in residence within the district occurs, the pupil shall transfer to the school which serves the new residence. Transfer is not mandatory when the pupil is in the highest grade level at his/her school.

Exception to School Attendance Area Requirement

In order for a child to attend a school other than the one which serves the pupil's area of residence, a written request by the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must be made to the Superintendent giving all reasons for the requested exception to the school attendance policy. After considering all educational aspects of the individual case and determining that class size and distribution of pupils among schools are not adversely affected, the Superintendent shall grant or deny the request.
