

## 0134 BOARD SELF EVALUATION

The Board of Education will conduct a self-evaluation on a periodic or regular basis. In the event the Board determines to conduct a self-evaluation, it will adopt an evaluation instrument that permits individual Board members to record their assessment of the conduct of the Board in fulfilling its responsibilities in accordance with applicable statutes and administrative codes. The Board may gather information from administration, the community and/or other sources as it deems appropriate.

The assessments will be tabulated by the Board President or designee and presented for discussion at a regular meeting of the Board in which the Superintendent and administration will be invited to participate. The Board will formulate, as appropriate, goals and priorities that will serve to guide the Board's future conduct.
