

3433 VACATIONS

The Board of Education believes that the school district benefits when teaching staff members employed to work twelve months a year are given periodic relief from the responsibilities of their positions without loss of compensation. Vacation time is earned as the employee works and becomes available for use on the following July 1.

The Board authorizes the Superintendent to determine the conditions under which vacation time may be taken when not otherwise covered by the terms of a negotiated agreement or in an individual contract with the Board. The number of vacation days an employee earns per year will mirror the entitlement in one of the collective negotiations agreements in effect in the district as determined by the Superintendent, or such other number as may be recommended by the Superintendent and approved by the Board.
